2. Issue: Sound Distortion in Large Stone Sanctuaries. Solution: Installing digital signal processors (DSP) and line-array speakers that can steer audio beams away from reflective stone surfaces and toward the congregation.
3. Issue: Managing Hall Hire Scheduling Conflicts. Solution: Deploying a centralized cloud-based calendar system (such as Google Workspace or specialized parish software) to allow real-time booking and prevent double-booking of community spaces.
