Electronic Control Units (ECU) and the CAN-Bus System

The E90 platform uses a **Controller Area Network (CAN-Bus)** to allow various modules (DME, CAS, DSC, FRM) to communicate. The service manual provides the pin-out diagrams for the **Digital Motor Electronics (DME)**, which is critical when diagnosing no-start conditions or communication errors between the **Cruise Control** module and the throttle body.
